If you're involved in an accident, here are some important things to remember:

- Stay calm.
- If anyone is injured, attend to them first.
- If there is someone who is injured or if livestock are involved, you must contact the Police within 24 hours.
- Warn approaching drivers of the accident.
- Use this brochure to take down full details of the accident.

Remember: Even if you think you may have been at fault, do not admit liability or offer payment to any other party. It's important we look at all the information available to confirm the cause; otherwise this may prejudice any legal action we take on your behalf.
